NESHAP is offering an undergraduate student scholarship for the 28th consecutive year. We are happy to announce a <u>\$1000 scholarship</u> to be awarded during Spring 2024 semester. Eligible applicants <u>must</u> be full time, 1^{st} or 2^{nd} semester juniors, in speech pathology or audiology programs at the specified regional universities. They must maintain a 3.3 or higher QPA and be members of NSSLHA.

Application Instructions

- 1. Complete and submit the application form with required signatures
- 2. Submit two current letters of recommendation written by professionals in the speech-language pathology or audiology field. *These letters should address personal qualities that are desired in clinicians, such as empathy, sensitivity to the needs of others, passion for advocacy, anger at injustice, etc.*
- 3. Submit a transcript (official or unofficial) reflecting performance through the Fall 2023 semester. This transcript must include your cumulative QPA.
- 4. Submit: an essay addressing one of the following topics:
 - a. What obstacles have you overcome that have contributed to your growth as a student?
 - b. What personal experiences have you had that will increase your sensitivity to your client's individual needs?
 - c. Describe a life lesson that you have learned as a result of something you did not do as well as you hoped.

This essay must be typed and double-spaced. It may not exceed two pages.

5. Submit a statement indicating whether or not you grant permission to have your essay in its entirety appear on NESHAP's website (<u>http://neshap.org/index.</u>) Only the essay of the winning recipient will appear.

Submission Procedure

Please prepare a <u>single</u> PDF document that contains the above items, in the order listed.
